Ninth Global Assembly of the World Movement for Democracy in Dakar

Juan Pablo Cardenal and Gabriel Salvia, Associate Researcher and the General Director of CADAL, respectively, participated in the ninth assembly of the World Movement for Democracy (WMfD) that occurred from May 6 to 9 in the Senegalese capital, which brought together more than three hundred activists from all over the world. The assembly pursued a strategic construction of alliances for the renewal of democracy.

Panel about Cuba at the Forum 2000 in Prague

In cooperation with Forum 2000, CADAL organized a panel about Cuba on October 8, moderated by Gabriel Salvia and marking the 22nd meeting originally created by Václav Havel, which occurs annually in Prague. At the forum, the independent Cuban artists Tania Bruguera and Luis Manuel Otero Alcántara examined the human rights situation in their country, in particular analyzing the restrictions of freedom of cultural expression.



CADAL at the 6th Latin American Conference of Think Tanks in Uruguay


From September 12 to 14th, Hernán Alberro, Programs Director of the Center for the Opening and Development of Latin America (CADAL), participated in the 6th Latin American Conference of Think Tanks: "A Bridge over Troubled Waters and Turbulent Times." CADAL was one of the four Argentine think tanks invited to participate in the conference, which brought together 70 representatives of various regional organizations.



In 2018, CADAL edited 30 publications, among them 4 books, 19 Documents, 3 Reports, and 4 issues of Cuban Latino Dialogue, as well as 43 noteworthy mentions in the press.
